Cluster Visioning

On the Sunday when we talked about our Re-Imagine 2.0 campaign I gave a brief history of our LFC family. We have a great legacy and history, but as I said that day, I believe we are just getting going.

This applies to so many areas of our ministry and impact in our community, but I feel that it is very true of our work through Clusters.

I believe the organization of our LFC community around the neighbourhoods and areas where people live is vital to our long-range vision to see the gospel of Jesus Christ making a difference through us.

There have been many stories of the Clusters working together, caring for one another and caring for others in the neighbourhood. While there have been great stories of success, there has also been some confusion about what the primary roles of Clusters are, and how Clusters are to function.

During my message on the Sunday of our Fall Kick-Off, I said that the Clusters exist for two main purposes. They are:

- To care for one another in the neighbourhood, and
- To care for the neighbourhood with one another

I believe that if we can develop the Clusters to do these two things well, then we will see great fruit for God's Kingdom.

To see our Clusters succeed and grow in their impact, we need to work together as a team in each Cluster. This was never meant to be a task for one or two people. The Clusters were developed with the idea of teams of people working together and sharing their unique gifts to make a difference.

With that in mind I would like to invite everyone to a Cluster Visioning Meeting to share ideas about what Clusters can be, and to give each Cluster a chance to dream about the impact they can make.
