Gospel Story Telling: Part 2
Clinging to the Perfect Christ and Embracing Your Perfection in Christ

Last month I used this article to begin writing about our desire to be a community of Gospel Storytellers. Throughout the month of April, I have been utilizing our weekly email newsletter to present a step by step process of developing your own Gospel Story. I began last month by dissecting our definition of the Gospel: "Imperfect people, clinging to the perfect Christ, being made perfect through the Holy Spirit and helping other imperfect people".

I wrote about "Embracing The Imperfect Without Embracing the Imperfection." In this instalment I would like to address the issue of "Clinging to the Perfect Christ and Embracing Your Perfection in Christ".



If you are like me, you feel anything but perfect. It is easy for us to see nothing but the struggles, the hurts, the screw ups and the sin that envelops us as human beings. I often can feel that there is very little good in me and so much that is broken or wrong. Well, that might just very well be true, as this seems to be the definition of being human.

The amazing story of grace that we have available to us has the power to change that reality, at least from God's perspective. When we embrace God's gift of grace, and allow his cleansing blood to wash over our sin and shame, we become as beautiful and pure to our heavenly Father as He sees His own Son Jesus.

For those of us who are on the inside looking out, that is very hard to believe, but from God's vantage point it is abundantly clear. I believe that when we begin to see ourselves as God sees us, we begin the process of becoming the person that God knows us to be.

A dear ministry mentor of mine by the name of Dann Spader once walked a group of us through some writing by theologian and Bible scholar Lewis Sperry Chafer, where Chafer lists 33 works of God that comprise the salvation of the soul. I have often gone back to this teaching, especially when I am feeling very weak and human. This to me comprises the reality of "clinging to the perfect Christ" as it is through his perfection that these gifts are ours. Please let me list these 33 things for you.

- I am forgiven
- I am a child of God
- I have access to God
- I am reconciled
- I am justified
- I have a place in Christ
- I am acceptable to God
- I have a heavenly citizenship
- I am a part of the family of God
- I have a heavenly association

April has been a busy and great month for the building addition. Let me give you in simple point form, the things that have been done over the last month or so:

 Drywall mudding and taping has been completed for the new addition.

 Painting the walls has begun and will soon be completed.

 Re-roofing the existing south side building is complete.

 Electrical connections and finishing for the north addition is underway.

 Sprinkler contractor has completed rough-in on the north side and in the sanctuary.

 The new mothers room is being built and there will be a new stair and entry to the mechanical room. This will allow us to remove the existing exterior stairway so stucco can be done.

 The stucco work has begun on the north addition. There will be many phases so you will be able to see the different stages as work progresses.

We hope to be moving the offices by the end of May. The construction crew will be starting ground work for the South addition soon as well.
